Church of the Little Flower Parish Operating Budget Report July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020

Dear Parishioners,

Our parish was more than halfway through our last fiscal year, and we were on track for a rather normal financial year, when the arrival of the Coronavirus changed our trajectory. Like most of you, we were faced with a new normal that challenged us to find new ways of conducting and financing our ministries. We are blessed with a solid financial foundation, a generous and willing group of parishioners and a very hard working staff. As you will see in the attached, because we are so blessed, we remain well able to conduct our ministries, operate our school and take care of our people. Things have changed, as you can readily see by our tent in the schoolyard.

There were two things in particular that saw us through the worst of the pandemic closures. First, the parish participated in the government's Payroll Protection Plan (PPP). This allowed us to retain our workforce through the fiscal and school year and relieved what would have been a pay burden from our operating budget. Without the PPP, we would have ended the year with a small deficit. Secondly, the parishioners that participate in our online giving program were a godsend. With no services in the church for some extended time, offertory giving was essentially lost from our in-church givers. Because of our online giving, we were able to maintain a significant part of our usual weekend collection. Online giving literally kept us going. If you do not now use online giving, specifically Faith Direct, please consider doing so now. The lesson is clear. It keeps the lights on and the ministries active.

While this report usually provides a list of the many projects and repairs we funded during the year, let me instead list for you some of the many extra costs, pandemic requirements, we were able to fund thanks to your generosity. We purchased disinfecting equipment, like the sprayer you may have seen the maintenance force using to disinfect the Church after every use. We have procured literally boxes and boxes of disinfecting wipes, hand sanitizers (I'm sure you've seen them at all the entrances to our buildings), gloves, masks and other Personal Protection Equipment (PPE). These consumables are replenished regularly. We added an additional maintenance worker to help with the expanded work, funded many initiatives to make the school pandemic-ready as it has been operating in-person classes for the last seven weeks and we bought our tent!

I continue to take my responsibilities as the steward for our parish's resources very seriously. And while I remain watchful to ongoing unanticipated Coronavirus related expenses, I remain confident we can maintain both our fiscal health and the physical well-being of our parishioners, students and staff. It would be very helpful if you would consider on-line giving through Faith Direct if you have not already joined. 35+% of our parishioners have already moved to online giving and it has paid dividends to us during this challenging time. As always, I ask for your prayers and support as we go about God's work in this parish, school and community. And be assured of my prayers and those of my fellow priests, deacons and the sisters for you and your families. And may God bless you for your unfailing generosity and support during this challenging time, as you continue to contribute your treasure, your time and your talents to our wonderful parish community.
